# What Level Am I?

Whether you are trying to figure out how to put on your boots or how to get to the best powder stashes, *SSU* has the right program for you! Read on to match your skills to the lesson level that will allow you to reach your goals.

<b>LEVEL 1:</b>	“Never-ever” — you have not skied or ridden in the past.
<b>LEVEL 2:</b>	You can turn and stop on Sir Henry’s Hill and are getting ready for the chairlift. You would like to begin linking turns both ways on easiest green terrain.
<b>LEVEL 3:</b>	You are able to easily link turns in both directions on easiest green terrain and would like to begin exploring more green terrain at Morse mid-station and the Highlands. Skiers’ skis are parallel throughout most of the turn.
<b>LEVEL 4:</b>	You are comfortable on all green terrain and would like to explore intermediate trails and natural snow trails on Morse Mountain. Skiers’ skis are parallel throughout the entire turn; riders are linking toe-side and heel-side turns.
<b>LEVEL 5:</b>	You are comfortable on all blue terrain on Morse Mountain and are ready to tackle skiing or riding intermediate groomed blue terrain on the upper mountains. Skiers’ skis are parallel throughout the entire turn; riders are linking toe-side and heel-side turns.
<b>LEVEL 6:</b>	You link turns and ski or ride confidently on all blue groomed terrain and most blue ungroomed areas. You would like to work towards skiing or riding groomed black diamond trails and intermediate woods and bumps.
<b>LEVEL 7:</b>	You are confident on all blue terrain and would like to expand your experience to the most difficult terrain, starting with mastering black groomed trails and progressing to exploring bumps and woods areas.
<b>LEVEL 8:</b>	You are a confident all-mountain skier or rider looking to hone your skills on a variety of terrain and snow conditions. You would like to expand your skills to off-piste areas and terrain parks.
<b>LEVEL 9:</b>	You are an aggressive all-mountain skier or rider interested in pushing yourself to the limit. You want to ski or ride it all, from deep powder in the woods to big air in the terrain parks.

**We Give You What You Want!** Beginner to expert, individual attention will help you take your skills to the next level.

Looking for individual instruction as you hit the slopes for the first time? Want to carve up groomers, float on powder or explore hidden woods stashes? Try a private lesson with one of our experienced, professional ski or snowboard instructors.

Private lessons are the perfect way to be introduced to a new discipline such as telemark, or develop new skill sets in the bumps, powder, trees, terrain parks, or race course. If you are new to the mountain or are up for an adventure, your private lesson instructor can serve as your guide as you explore the exciting and varied terrain that Smuggs has to offer.

**Choose from a variety of options designed to address your specific interests and goals:**

**Individual Private Lessons for Adults and Children:** Offered in one hour increments, lessons focus on the skier or rider's individual interests and goals, and are tailored to their abilities and confidence level.

**Semi-private Lessons for Adults and Children:** Two or more skiers or riders may choose to be coached together according to their common and individual goals and desire to spend their on-hill time with family or friends.

**6-hour Private Instruction or Guided Tours for Adults and Children:** Ideal for the individual or group looking for personal private instruction and guiding for the entire day. With your coach you can spend the whole day enhancing your skills and exploring the mountains, or you can split the day according to the different ages and abilities within the group.

**Mom & Me/Dad & Me:** Get a look inside an SSU Instructors' "bag of tricks"! Coaches will share teaching strategies with Mom or Dad to assist the parent in teaching a little one to ski or ride. Emphasis is on fun and strengthening the parent-child bond. The parent must be an intermediate or better skier or rider.

## Little Rascals on Snow

Ski instruction for ages 2 1/2 - 3 years

We've found a way to teach children as young as 2 1/2 years old, and still in diapers, to love the sport of skiing as much as we do. The secret? Let them play with the equipment until their curiosity is piqued. Then, once enticed, we head out onto the snow to start sliding under careful supervision, always finishing while they are still interested and always concluding on a positive note.

Because continuity and familiarity are key with this age group, the specially trained caregivers that play with your child and take care of their needs indoors at *TREASURES* will also serve as the instructors who guide your child through the Little Rascals learning experience on skis.

Kids in this program enjoy the fun and ease of use of a Wonder Carpet conveyor lift, conveniently located right out the back door of *TREASURES*. Each week, children enrolled in *Little Rascals on Snow* showcase their new skills on a small course. After the children finish the course, families enjoy warm, homemade cookies and hot chocolate together as part of this special event.

### **TREASURES Child Care Center**

*TREASURES*, our state-of-the-art child care center, is filled to the brim with toys and games and is fully licensed by the State of Vermont. *TREASURES*, located on Morse Mountain next to the village lift line, has some very special features for both kids and parents including radiant floor heating, giant fish tanks, a mountainside enclosed playground, 5400 square feet of indoor space, one-way mirror viewing for parents and easy drop off and pick up. The staff is trained in first aid, CPR, child development and behavior management. Our child-to-caregiver ratio assures full attention and the best possible care.

### A DAY IN DISCOVERY CAMP

9:00 am

Children are greeted by their instructors and get settled into their respective groups. Coloring supplies and toys help kids engage with their group and feel at home.

9:15 am - 10:30 am

First time skiers and riders play boot games and ski/snowboard games inside in order to get used to their equipment in a comfortable atmosphere. When they are ready to take their new skills to the snow, they will take a wagon ride to Sir Henry's Learning Hill. There they will learn the basics of sliding and gliding on their equipment.

Experienced skiers and riders will board the wagon and head right out to *Mogul Mouse's* Magic Lift for the morning.

Lunch in the Lower Meeting House.

12:00 Noon

Back to the slopes for an afternoon of sliding and gliding!

2:15 pm

Children return to the Lower Meeting House for warm-up and free play before afternoon entertainment.

For Winter 2011-2012, Smugglers' has been working with Vermont's Burton Snowboards to develop the next generation of the Burton Riglet Park, an on-snow play area with fun terrain features designed for introducing young children to snowboarding. The park's focal point is a "treehouse," an elevated platform with ramps that children can ride down, a balance zone inside the treehouse and a lift chair that swings to help kids practice getting on and off the lift. Playing in the park on small rolling hills, miniature box-style rails, pyramids and a mini-halfpipe allows children to gain the necessary

balancing skills to begin sliding and making turns on sloped terrain. The park is located at the Sir Henry's Learning Area with conveyor lift access and is available specifically for our *Discovery Dynamos* Snowboard Program. The learning process in Discovery is eased by a low camper-to-instructor ratio and the indoor use of balance boards and other fun activities to prepare kids for on-slope balancing and riding. On the snow, these young children benefit from Burton's riglet reel, a retractable cord attached to the snowboard that enables an instructor to guide the child over features with ease and allows for quick repetition. With tools like these, starting young children out on snowboards has never been so fun and easy!

## HOW TO USE THE RIGLET PARK

## ALL-DAY CAMP

Adventure and Notch Squad campers ski and ride, have lunch and attend afternoon entertainment with their instructor and group. Levels 1-4 ski and ride in the Morse and Morse Highlands areas on a variety of terrain types including natural and man made snow surfaces, woods trails, bumps and park features. All terrain has been specifically designed and maintained to accommodate newer skiers and riders and make learning fun and safe. Levels 5-9 ski and ride on Sterling and Madonna mountains and use the diverse terrain to hone their skills on the groomers as well as in the bumps and the woods. Indoor afternoon entertainment begins at 2:30 pm for those who would like to take a break from the slopes. Choose Extended Camp to give advanced skiers and riders a chance to explore the mountain until 4:00 pm.

## GROUP LESSONS AND MAX5 SESSIONS

2-hour morning group lessons and afternoon MAX5 sessions for skiers and snowboarders help kids develop the confidence to explore the mountain, be smart on the slopes and have fun. Levels 1-4 use the Morse mountain area and Levels 5-9 use the Sterling and Madonna areas. Morning group lessons guide and instruct kids in a group setting with emphasis on mountain safety and plenty of mileage. Afternoon MAX5 lessons guarantee a group size of five or fewer, allowing kids to benefit from more specific instruction and individual attention to perfect their skills.

**Meeting Location:** SSU Greeting Area on Morse Mountain. Meet at 9:45 am for 10:00 am group lesson and 12:45 pm for 1:00 pm MAX5 session.



**Master the Mountain (Levels 5-9):** You want to feel more confident on blue and black trails, but prefer to spend most of your time on groomed terrain. Groups will be formed according to terrain interest and pacing similarities.

**Meeting Location:** Sterling SSU Building. Meet at 9:45 am for 10:00 am group lesson and 12:45 pm for 1:00 pm MAX5 session.

**Terrain Tactics (Levels 5-9):** You want to spend most of your time on ungroomed terrain. Depending on the day's conditions you will tackle bumps, glades and steeps with your instructor serving as a guide and coach. Groups will be formed according to terrain interest and pacing similarities.

**Meeting Location:** Sterling SSU Building. Meet at 9:45 am for 10:00 am group lesson and 12:45 pm for 1:00 pm MAX5 session.

### The Mountain Experience for Skiers (Levels 4-9)

Guided by our most experienced instructors, you and no more than 5 people with similar goals and abilities will explore our diverse and challenging terrain with occasional tips to help you build confidence. If you're comfortable skiing on groomed, blue trails and want to expand your horizons, this 4-hour program is for you and is offered daily. *\$129 per adult per day. The Hearth & Candle Restaurant serves a gourmet meal with appetizer, salad, choice of main course, and a famous dessert. After dinner, work off those calories with a 40 minute snowshoe down to the Base Lodge. This is truly a rustic experience with no bathrooms. B.Y.O.B. Advance registration at the Guest Service Desk is required. \$69 per person. Function will be cancelled in the event of severe weather. Sign-up deadline Tuesday at 12:00 noon, no refunds for cancellations after this time. ## Night School for Boarding

The perfect place for folks who want to learn how to snowboard, but either don't have time during the day or would rather spend lift-turning hours ripping up the rest of the mountain. It is also a great place for new riders to hone skills they have been working on. The environment is relaxed and friendly and run by our professional snowboard instructors.

The program is split into two sections. First, students will have an hour and a half of on-snow instruction from the Night School staff. After the lesson, the last hour will be spent lapping the magic carpet, practicing their newly acquired skills under the watchful eye of the instructors.

## Night School for Jibbing

Night School for Jibbing happens at the same place and time as our Night School for Boarding program. It is, however, much different in content. In order to participate in the Jib School, you must be able to ski or ride competently. If you can ride the chairlift to mid station, and make it down while successfully turning both ways and stopping, then you are ready to try our Night Jibbing. If not, we recommend practicing your skills a little more at regular night school before joining the jibbers!

Sir Henry's will be set up with small kickers, boxes, and other features to serve as a mini-park. This is a great place for any skier or rider to learn the skills they need to one day become a park expert. Don't hesitate even if you have no park experience! Night School is a non-intimidating atmosphere and welcoming to even the most novice of jibbers!

Smugglers' Notch Adaptive Program (SNAP) is dedicated to providing a fun experience in a supportive environment.

Experiences are tailored to meet the needs and goals of each individual. Some participants may require two instructors, while others may be appropriately paired.

We also offer an inclusion program. This gives a child with a disability the opportunity to socialize with his/her peers while still maintaining the support he/she needs through the SNAP program.

Half and full day lessons are available. Half-day lessons run from 9:00 am - 12:00 Noon and 1:00 pm - 4:00 pm. Our highly trained instructors will evaluate each individual's needs and goals to determine their equipment needs. The SNAP program maintains an inventory of adaptive equipment including mono-skis, bi-skis and a slider. Snowboarding is also available.

## WHAT TO WEAR

## CHILDREN'S PROGRAMS

**Drop-off and Pick-up:** Arrive early to get your child settled into the proper group and get to know the instructor! At the end of the day, leave plenty of time at pick-up to hear from your child's instructor about the day's activities.

**Information Cards:** Each child should arrive at their meeting location with a completed information card to give to his or her instructor.
