Ride to the top of the Morse lift, explore untracked trails with breathtaking views. Mondays trek descends gradually to the base of Madonna Mountain and Thursdays trek descends to the base of Whiteface Mountain. Beginners welcome! \$48 per person, equipment and lift access provided.

Maple Experience Snowshoe Trek ■ Tues. 1:00 pm - 3:00 pm Join us on a guided trek through Vermont's pristine woods and learn about the liquid gold that runs through our maple trees. Learn to identify the different types of

maple trees and techniques involved in maple sugaring, a time honored Vermont tradition. Bring home a sample of pure maple syrup. \$48 per person, equipment provided.

Snowshoe Adventure Dinner Tues. 4:10 pm - 8:30 pm
